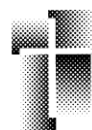

Carpool Tips

For the safety of the students, a new rule has been instituted in the past few months during carpool. As the cars are still moving, students' names/numbers are called. The students are then allowed to stand up and walk up or down the sidewalk to stand near where their car eventually stops. None of the students are allowed to step off the sidewalk until ALL the cars have stopped moving, including the cars at the very back of the line. When every car has stopped moving, the announcement "Ready to load" is made and students are free to cross the street, if needed, and get into cars. Some students towards the front of the line have been edging too close to the cars, throwing backpacks through open windows, leaning against the cars, or getting into cars before the announcement is made. Please discuss this at home as teachers are presently reinforcing this rule in the classroom as well. The safety and health of all the students is the ultimate goal!
