Donations/Volunteers Needed for Catholic Youth Camp

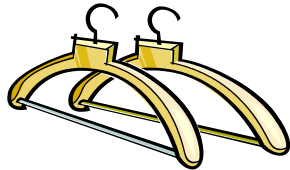
