**Manual Orders:** The cost of the first yearbook is \$35 and the cost of any additional yearbook(s) is \$30. Payments must be made by cash or check and turned into the front office. Please print forms from Edline by clicking on the “Yearbook” folder located to the right under the Contents heading.

You will be emailed a confirmation for your Yearbook order. If you purchase a yearbook manually and do not receive a confirmation within one week of your order, please email Layne at [missigman@earthlink.net](mailto:missigman@earthlink.net).

**Online Orders:** The cost of each book is \$35 regardless of how many books you purchase. However, online you can purchase your yearbook(s) with MasterCard, Visa, Discover, or American Express. Online orders are subject to a \$1 processing fee per book purchased. Customize your yearbook with iTags, name stamping, or plastic covers.

Customization is available for online purchases only. To purchase a yearbook online, login to your Edline account and click on the “Yearbook” folder located to the right, then click on “Buy a Yearbook” and follow instructions on the website.

The second sale begins November 17<sup>th</sup> and the cost of the yearbook(s) for manual orders will be \$40 for the first book and \$35 for any additional books. Online purchases will be \$40 for each yearbook purchased.
