As part of our Lenten commitment, we would like each of you to partner, too. The average cost for a patient visit is \$60, and Shepherd's Hope relies on caring community partners to help pay for this cost. A prescription is often part of the visit and it costs approximately \$8 per patient to pay for these medications. That is where you can help!



Shepherd's Hope provides non-emergency medical care, hope and healing to low-income, uninsured men, women, and children who do not qualify for government assisted healthcare.

There is no charge for a visit to one of the nine health centers located in Seminole and Orange counties, which are staffed by over 2,500 volunteers, including doctors and nurses.
