NJHS Application Guidelines

- Membership is open to all 7th and 8th Grade students
- Must have an overall combined grade average of 94% in the first trimester in language arts, math, science, social studies and Spanish.
 - *Students in gifted math must have an average of 93% in the subject areas listed above.
 - *All students must maintain a 90% average in the five academic courses once inducted.
- Students must be in good standing in regard to conduct. Students earning 4 negative
 infractions resulting in a detention will be asked to speak to the NJHS Faculty Council
 regarding their conduct. Students earning 8 infractions will be dismissed from NJHS.
- Students will not be eligible for membership status if they earn any 3's in the Learner Behavior section of the report card. If already a member and 3's are earned, the student will be placed on probation for the remainder of the trimester.
- The extracurricular and community service forms are used as an indicator for student achievement in the areas of service, leadership, and citizenship.
 - <u>Extracurricular activities</u>: This includes, but is not limited to clubs, teams, and musical groups. Examples
 include Quill Society, sports teams, plays, student council, band, safety patrol or scouts.
 - There is a space reserved on this form for any **leadership positions** that you may have held. This includes any leadership positions held in school or community organizations. Examples include but are not limited to captain/co-captain of a sports team, student council representative, 1st chair in band, the lead in a play, assistant coach or camp counselor.
 - Community Service: This includes activities in which students participate outside of school for the betterment of the community. Examples include but are not limited to altar serving, church nursery/Sunday School helper, Vacation Bible School, Fall Festival, Walk for the Poor, community service work, Spring/Fall Social, concession stand for sports teams, Children's Liturgy of the Word, or Annunciation Parish Food Pantry.
 - Keep track of the service hours performed. They must be well documented and signed off by the **adult in charge** (not a parent). Seventh grade applicants must have at least 20 service hours and eighth grade applicants must have at least 30 service hours.
- **Service and extracurricular forms can be found on the ACA website under Campus Life > Clubs or from Mrs. Aziz.

 Documentation of service hours and extracurricular activities may be accumulated from August of 6th grade through 8th grade.
- **Extracurricular and community service forms should be completed and turned in to Mrs. Aziz by 3:00 PM on the last day of the first trimester. **No late forms will be accepted**.
- **Forms turned in without signatures will not be accepted.
- **For students placed on academic probation, the grades reported on the next trimester report card will determine continued eligibility.
- **Students receiving any school suspension will not be eligible for membership and NJHS members will lose membership if a school suspension is earned.
- ** NJHS members involved in a cheating incident will receive a warning letter. A second incident will warrant dismissal from NJHS.
- **Students for whom accommodations have been made and are taking classes for a nonnumeric grade are not eligible for NJHS.
